#### AI-004 - Communicable Diseases

### 1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to communicable diseases that the Chief of Police will:
  - develop and maintain procedures that are consistent with the most recent edition of the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care's Preventing and Assessing Occupational Exposures to Selected Communicable Diseases - An Information Manual for Designated Officers:
  - 2. designate and train one or more members as a Communicable Disease Coordinator(s);
  - ensure that each Communicable Disease Coordinator is provided with a copy of the most recent edition of the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care's Preventing and Assessing Occupational Exposures to Selected Communicable Diseases - An Information Manual for Designated Officers; and
  - 4. work, where possible, with the local medical officer of health, to develop a post-exposure plan that addresses roles and responsibilities, reporting protocols, medical evaluation, intervention, confidentiality, access to treatments and follow-up support for workers who have suffered a high-risk occupational exposure to a communicable disease.

## 2.0 Administration

2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2014 and shall take effect on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015.
