LE-007 - Hate/Bias Motivated Crime

1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to undertaking and managing investigations into hate/bias motivated crime that the Chief of Police will:
 - ensure that community organizations, school boards, victims' organizations, social services agencies, and the media are informed about the police service's procedures for investigating hate/bias motivated crime;
 - ensure that the police service works, where possible, with community organizations, school boards, victims' organizations, and social service agencies to prevent the repetition of hate/bias motivated crime and to counter the activities of organized hate groups in the community;
 - c) develop and maintain procedures on and processes for undertaking and managing investigations into hate/bias motivated crime;
 - d) ensure that officers are provided with information on hate/bias motivated crime;
 - e) ensure that the police service works with other law enforcement and government agencies to respond to hate/bias motivated crime and the activities of organized hate groups; and
 - f) assess and report back to the board on the need for, cost and feasibility of establishing a dedicated unit to investigate hate/bias motivated crime.
