## LE-015 - Paid Informants and Agents

#### 1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to paid informants and agents that the Chief of Police will:
- a) establish procedures and processes relating to the use and management of paid informants and agents; and
- b) establish procedures on the use of in-custody informants that are consistent with the procedures set out in the Ministry's designated **Ontario Major Case Management Manual.**

## 2.0 Administration

- 2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2015 and shall take effect on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015.
- 2.2 That this policy be unrestricted.
