LE-021 - Elder and Vulnerable Adult Abuse

1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to elder and vulnerable adult abuse that the Chief of Police will:
- a) where possible, work in partnership with the local Crown, municipalities, community and social service agencies/providers, businesses, seniors' and other local organizations to develop programs for preventing and responding to complaints of elder and vulnerable adult abuse, including fraud awareness and prevention; and
- develop and maintain procedures that require that investigations into elder or vulnerable adult abuse be undertaken and managed in accordance with the police service's criminal investigation management plan.
