LE-023 - Bail and Violent Crime

1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to bail and violent crime that the Chief of Police will establish procedures on bail and violent crime that address:
- a) assessing opposing bail on the secondary grounds;
- b) preparing the show cause report (bail hearing brief);
- c) post-bail hearing notifications; and
- d) breach of bail conditions.

2.0 Administration

- 2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20th day of October 2014 and shall take effect on January 1st 2015.
- 2.2 That this policy be unrestricted.
