## LE-028 - Criminal Harassment

- 1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to undertaking and managing investigations into criminal harassment that the Chief of Police will develop and maintain procedures that address:
  - a) the procedures for investigating criminal harassment complaints in accordance with the police service's criminal investigation management plan;
  - b) the use of enhanced investigative techniques, such as behavioural science services as part of the investigation;
  - c) the provision of victims' assistance;
  - d) the information to be provided to police officers on criminal harassment; and
  - e) compliance with the Ministry's designated *Ontario Major Case Management Manual* for criminal harassment cases that fall within the definition of major case.

## 2. Administration

- 2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2014 and shall take effect on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015.
- 2.2 That this policy be unrestricted.
