LE-033 – Prisoner Transportation

- 1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to prisoner transportation that the Chief of Police will:
 - a) establish procedures on prisoner transportation that require compliance by police officers/special constables with the police service's procedures on prisoner care and control;
 - ensure that police officers/special constables used to escort persons in custody have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform this function; and
 - c) ensure that appropriate safety equipment is used/available to police officers/special constables performing this function.

2. Administration

- 2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20th day of October 2014 and shall take effect on January 1st 2015.
- 2.2 That this policy be unrestricted.
