LE-040 - Parental and Non-Parental Abductions and Attempts

- 1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to parental and non-parental abductions and attempted abductions of children that the Chief of Police will:
 - a) develop and maintain procedures that require that investigations into parental/familial abductions and attempted abductions be undertaken in accordance with the police service's criminal investigation management plan; and
 - b) development and maintain procedures that require that investigations into non-parental/non-familial abductions and attempted abduction be undertaken in accordance with the procedures set out in the Ministry's designated *Ontario Major Case Management Manual*.
